

## Garbage Service

- · Garbage must be containerized in carts provided by Republic Services.
- All garbage must be placed in front of your own home and within 3 feet of the edge of the roadway.
- · Garbage must not be stacked over water or gas meters, under low hanging branches or utility wires or within 4 feet of mail boxes or fire hydrants (fixed objects: cars, car bumpers).

## Bulk Items

Example "Bulk Items" discarded furniture, toilets, sinks, and other similar household goods that will not fit into a standard garbage can. Bulk items must be placed at curb 3 feet away from Republic Services provided containers.

## Best Practices For Safety:

All mirrors, glass doors, glass table tops, pane glass windows, etc can be safely broken up to prevent injury. Place broken glass in containerized solid containers (no plastic bags) such as garbage cans or corrugated cardboard boxes. Container and contents must weigh less than 50 pounds.

### Yard Waste

- Yard waste includes debris from routine residential yard maintenance only. It does not include debris generated from land clearing or tree removal. All vegetation must be kept separate from other debris and be dirt and sand free.
- Yard waste is collected manually by a different truck than the garbage.
- Containers with contents cannot weigh more than 50 pounds.
- Branches must be 6 feet or less in length and 50 pounds or less in weight.

#### **DO NOT MIX YARD WASTE (VEGETATION)** WITH GARBAGE OR ANY OTHER DEBRIS

## Best Practices – Yard Waste

• Bag or place yard waste in a personal trash can marked as "yard waste", weight less than 50 pounds.

• Oversized yard waste piles exceeding 6' will be picked up by the claw truck on Wednesday of each week.

Please place shredded paper in a brown paper bag, fold the top down to secure and place in recycle bin. No plastic bags please!

Because contamination affects the marketability of the materials we collect, please be careful not to place the following in your bin:

Food Waste, needles, syringes, or hazardous waste.
